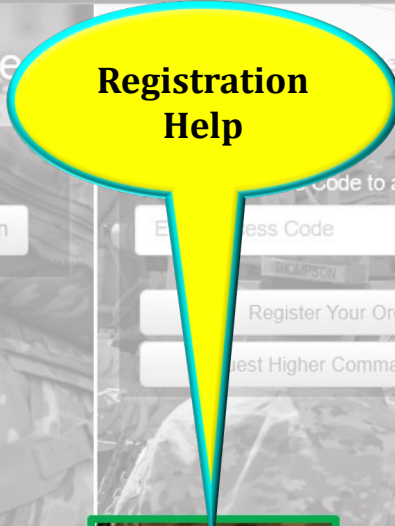

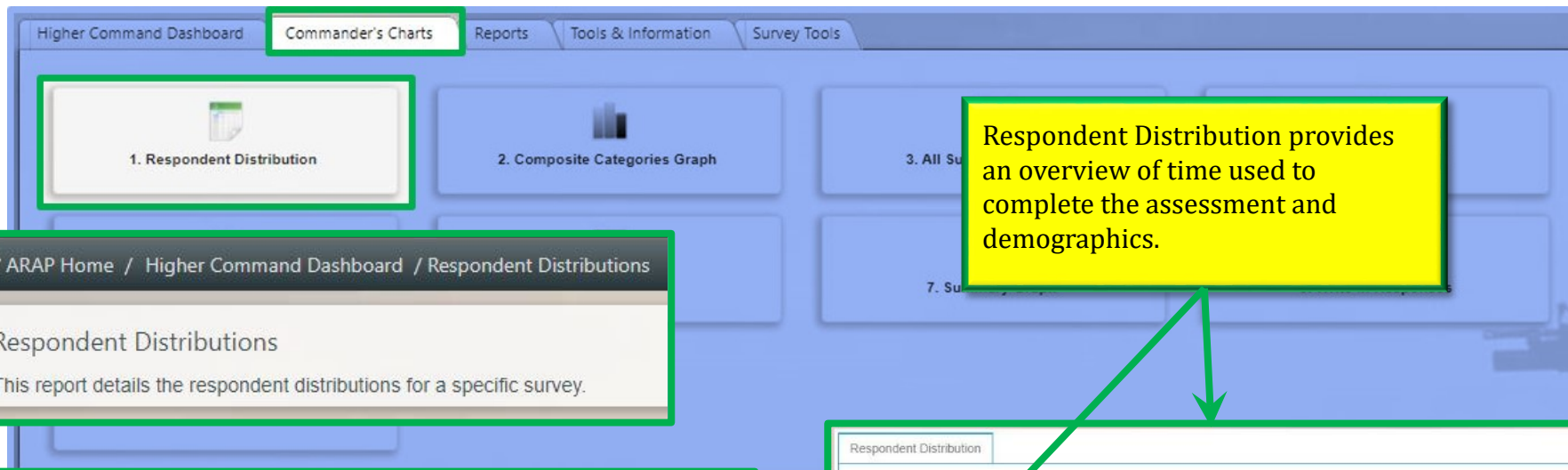
Statistical Confidence ■ Uncompleted Assessments

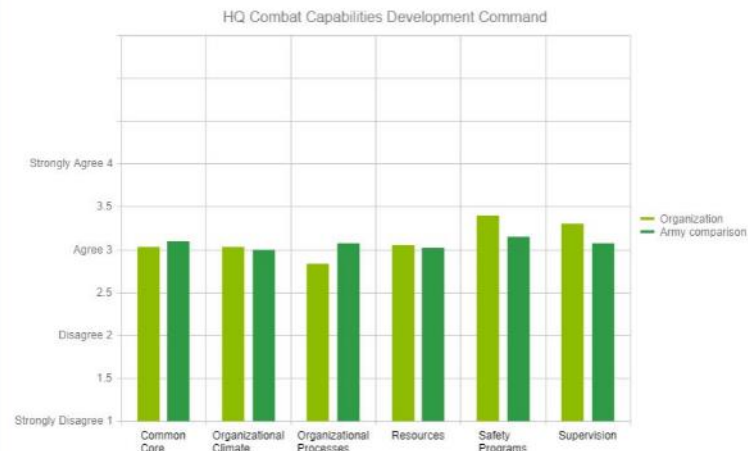

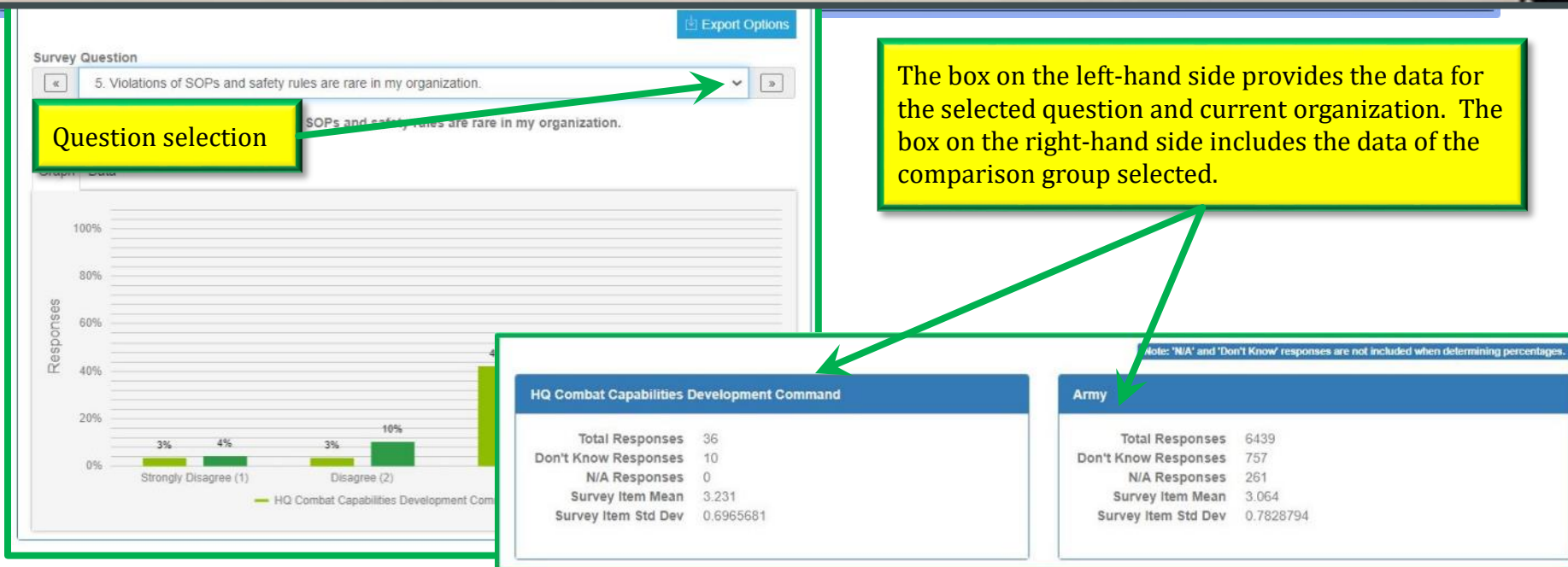

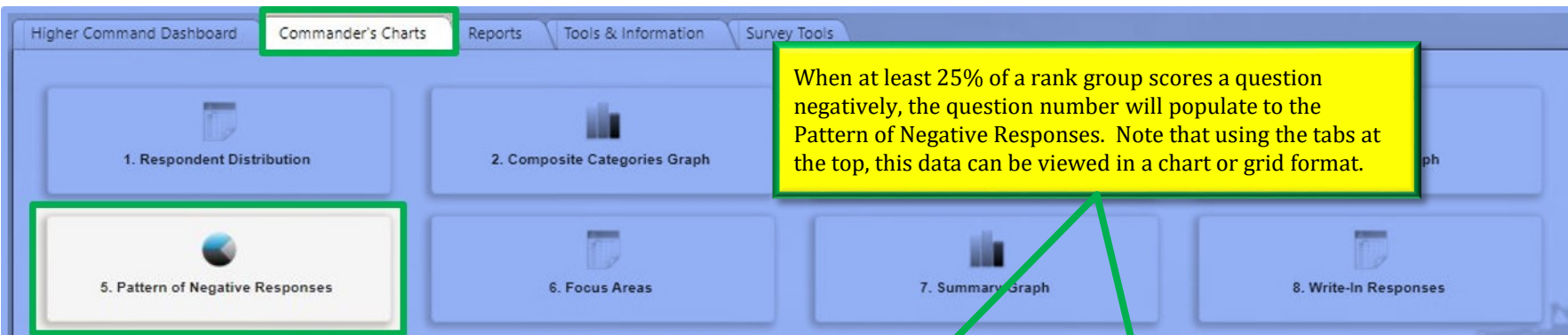

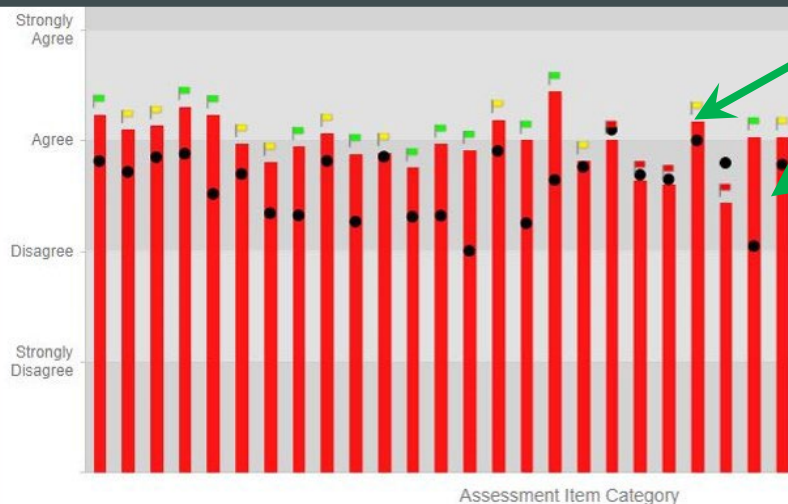
